- **Narrated City-Wide Historic Tours Aboard Molly the Trolley:** Tours begin at 9:00 a.m. at the Historic Fire Station, 11 Church Street, Presque Isle and last approximately 3 hours. - **FREE Guided Walking Tours** of Historic Downtown Presque Isle: The tours begin and end at the Vera Estey House, 16 Third Street, Presque Isle at 10:00 a.m. The tours last approximately two hours and cover two miles. On street parking is available. Reservations suggested.
